Subscription Service

Subscription will provide:

- Deposit loan collection of at least 2 books per pupil (minimum 200 books), refreshed by regular exchanges.
- Access to Bookshop Exhibition Collection and book ordering service (various discounts).
All books purchased through SLS can be exchanged through the Exchange service.
- Booklists, Newsletters, support groups membership.
- Discount for Junior Librarian and Alice training

Curriculum Topics Service

Subscription Service

NB. this subscription is for Primary and Special schools only

Subscription will provide:

- Curriculum topic collections consist of up to 20 books or other items provided on request.
The collections are tailored to teachers' requirements and intended to boost school resources on a temporary basis (usually one term but extended on request.)
- Booklists and Newsletters

Pay as You Use Services

- Curriculum topic collections of books and other items to boost school resources on a temporary basis (usually a term), on request, including Group Readers and Playsets packs.
- Advice and practical support on aspects of school libraries and book provision, including library planning and design, stock assessment, library organisation, information skills, stock promotion, reader development and assistance with self-evaluation.
- Support for Junior Librarian and Alice library management systems including installation, one-to-one / small group training in school and system health checks
- In-service training, courses, events and publications

Comprehensive Service Subscription Charge

Primary & Special schools: £891 per school plus £14.17 per pupil

Secondary schools: £1754 per school plus £5.18 per pupil

Library Support Service Subscription Charge

Primary & Special schools: £635 per school plus £12.02 per pupil

Secondary schools: £1425 per school plus £4.38 per pupil

Curriculum Topics Service Subscription Charge

Primary & Special schools: £677 per school plus £10.68 per pupil

Pay as you use Services and Prices

Curriculum topic collections of books and other items to boost school resources on a temporary basis, focused on specific areas of the curriculum.

10 books = £31 per term

20 books = £62 per term

Advice and practical support on aspects of school libraries and book provision, including library planning and design, stock assessment, library organisation, information skills, stock promotion, reader development and assistance with self-evaluation.

Subscribers £52 per hour/£250 daily rate

Non-subscribers £62 per hour/£300 daily rate

Terms and Conditions

- 1 Schools choosing the Comprehensive and Library Support subscriptions retain existing deposit loan collections.
- 2 Schools choosing the Curriculum Topic Service and Pay As You Use option, or choosing not to use the service at all, must relinquish any existing deposit loan collection.
- 3 SLS deposit or topic books which are not relinquished will be charged for at £7 per item.
- 4 Schools re-subscribing to the Comprehensive or Library Support Service at a later date may be charged an additional fee towards the set-up costs of a new deposit collection.
- 5 Where hourly rates are used, an estimate will be given beforehand and a maximum charge agreed (minimum charge of one hour).
- 6 Schools will receive an individual annual statement of services received.
