All you need to promote wide reading with Years 1-3

Ready Steady Read! is a collection of specially-commissioned artwork on a castle theme.

The inside of each tracker lists the genre or category of books to choose from; the reverse allows children to record the titles they have read. When children have read a book from a genre, they can choose a sticker to put over the title of that genre to add characters to their castle picture. There is a fun activity for each year group to enjoy when they have finished their tracker. To celebrate their success the children can be presented with a Ready, Steady, Reader certificate in assembly.
